- A: Register for free through <u>Eventbrite</u> and join us inside Hopin –an online events website– for this all-ages event on April 16-18, 2021!

The Hopin platform includes:

- Livestreamed presentations
- Film screenings
- Live panelist discussions
- Hands-on sessions with our activity presenters
- And virtual booths where you can speak one-on-one with people from math organizations all over the country!

Hopin access is limited to one entrance per registrant email address, so provided below are two different ways to share and join in the fun.

- 1. Send our Hopin e-Enrollment Kit home with your students. (Available on page 2) Parents, families, and caregivers can help students ages 13+ to register. Or parents can register and share the NMF Live Online Weekend with their younger students.
- 2. For high school teachers: Register yourself through Eventbrite, then screen share the Hopin event with your students on the day of the event. Please note: the Friday film events are appropriate for high school students and adults. (No registrations are required except your own.)

Unlike Zoom, you do not need to download or install any software prior to participating. Hopin is web-browser based. All you will need is access to the links and codes we provide.
